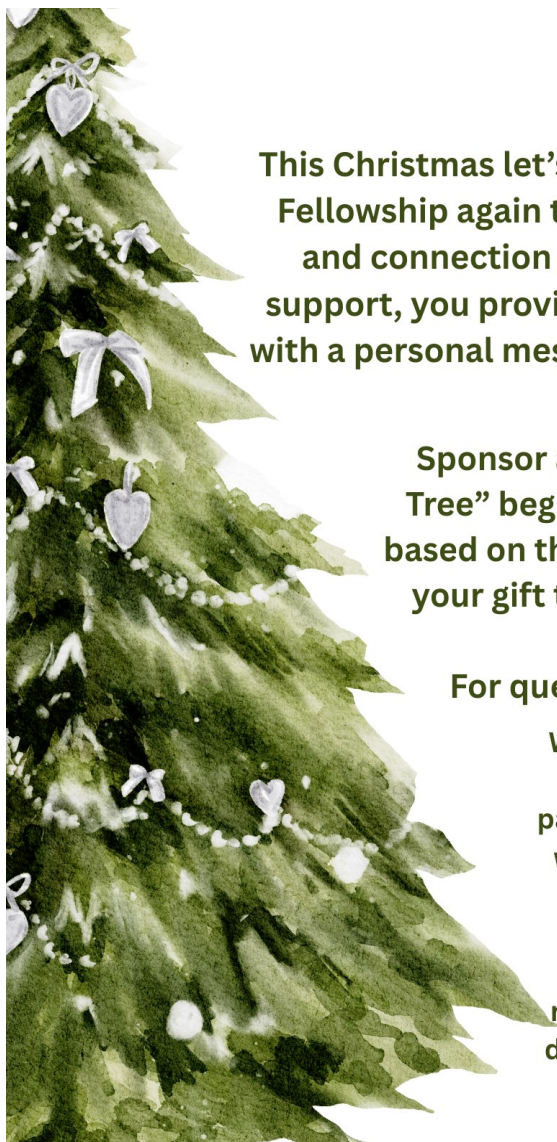
Angel Tree

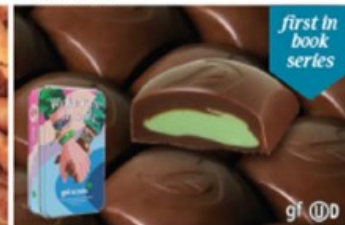
